

PSHE

This term we are focusing on healthy relationships with others and 13th November sees us involved in Anti-Bullying Week. This year's theme is "All Different, All Equal" as advocated by the Anti-Bullying Alliance.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

This half term we will be looking at LIGHT. How does light change how we see things? Why do Christians describe Jesus as the Light of the world? Who are our Lights? And of course we will be revisiting the Christmas story later in the term with our school production!

This term we will be looking at the author Ted Hughes and his book, The Iron Man. We will create our own fantasy stories, poetry, information texts and designing our own robots. Our spellings and grammar will be based on the new curriculum tricky words list and the Year 3 and 4 objectives.

MATHEMATICS

We will be focussing on fractions and decimals this term as well as multiplication and divisions. For our shape, space and measurement learning we will use our 2D and 3D shape understanding to design and create our own robots! We will revisit centimetres/metres and apply this to problem solving and creative Christmas activities.
